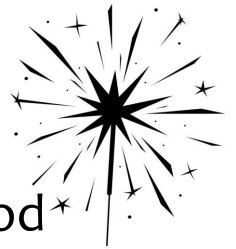


DAR Good Citizens Program

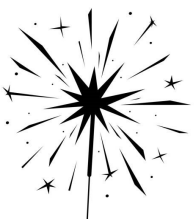
Outstanding young people who exhibit the qualities of good citizenship in their homes, schools, and communities *need recognized!* Chapters should contact local high schools to encourage their participation.

The DAR Good Citizens program and Scholarship Contest is intended to encourage and reward the sparkling qualities of good citizenship in our students. The program is open to all high school seniors enrolled in public or private schools accredited and in good standing with their state board of education.

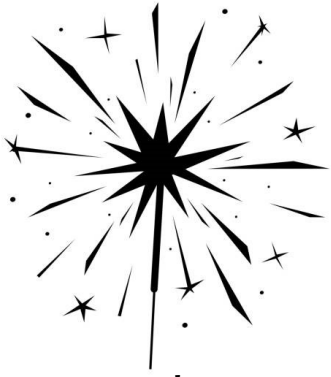


The student selected as the school's **DAR Good Citizen** must have the following qualities:

- * Dependability (truthfulness, honesty, punctuality, etc.)
- * Service (cooperation, helpfulness, responsibility, etc.)
- * Leadership (personality, self-control, initiative, etc.)
- * Patriotism (unselfish loyalty to American ideals)



Each school's **DAR Good Citizen** receives a DAR Good Citizen pin, certificate, and wallet recognition card. This student is then eligible, if they wish, to enter the DAR **Good Citizen Scholarship Contest**.

February 1: Chapter chair completes DAR Good Citizen section of Master Report (CMR) by February 1st, using PIN access code supplied by your Regent.
