At the national level DAR Project Patriot supports projects in six locations:

- **The Chaplain's Closet at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center** in Landstuhl, Germany. The committee coordinates with the Landstuhl Chaplain's Office to identify needed clothing items.
- **Brooke Army Medical Center** at San Antonio Military Medical Center in San Antonio, Texas.
- **Walter Reed National Military Medical Center** in Bethesda Maryland.
- **Camp Atterbury**, Indiana a Mobilization Training Center for deploying members from the Army and Air National Guard, Active and Reserve Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines.
- **Camp Pendleton**, California, the Marine Corps largest West Coast expeditionary training facility. DAR also works with the USO
- **Units Overseas** acting as a liaison between the units overseas and the military communities that they serve.
- **Fort Belvoir**, Virginia

More ways to support Project Patriot:

- **Thank you cards for our service members-** DAR members give out thank you cards when they are visiting them in medical facilities, when they see a car with a military sticker, and any occasion they have to thank out active military members. - **Gift Card Labels-** These labels include the DAR logo and state, "Thank you for your service and sacrifice for our country" These may be attached to cards, individual snacks and other items. - **Deployed women in military service-** Women appreciate receiving beauty and feminine products similar to those we use at home. Members are encouraged to send packages to deployed women who are known by chapter members.
