Committee Purpose

Welcome to the DAR Genealogy Preservation Committee where DAR volunteers Celebrate Stars & Stripes forever by preserving DAR records! This committee was established with the goal to index DAR genealogical, organizational, and membership information into computerized searchable databases. These indexed records are vital resources to DAR genealogists and registrars in the application approval and membership record retrieval processes. To date, the Chapter Caption Project, Pension Card Indexing Project and Real Daughter Project have been completed. The Descendants Project and the Supporting Documentation Project, while they are closed to new volunteers, continue to be maintained by a small group of volunteers transcribing and indexing new documents for these products.

The great news at this time is that the **Microfiche Project: Decades of Dazzling Data** will digitize and categorize approximately three million early supporting documents submitted with applications from the 1950's through the mid 1980's. However, the project development has just started, and it is estimated that it will take from six months to a year before volunteers can begin categorizing the documents. Additional information will be posted as it is made available on the NSDAR Committee webpage.
