### Chapter Regents and Treasurers:

The **Chapter Master Report (CMR)** provides the tools to recognize chapter members for outstanding, sparkling service in reaching the historic preservation, education, and patriotism goals and objectives of our Society. Your achievements and success as a chapter are important to us! The 2023 CMR reflects members and chapter activities and contributions for the period of January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023. To receive recognition, chapters are required to complete the CMR electronically through **eMembership BEFORE February 1, 2024**. The CMR will be posted in August. Don't wait until the last minute to begin processing it.

The mission of the **Chapter Achievement Awards (CAA)** is to recognize chapters for their exceptional work as it applies to ALL committees, and ALL chapter sizes. To receive recognition, chapters are required to **complete the CAA report electronically** through the Chapter Master Report (CMR) found on eMembership BEFORE February 1, 2023. ***No paper copies will be accepted.***

**The top four chapters with the highest CAA points for their chapter category, based on chapter sizes, will be recognized with a CAA certificate.**

### Chapter Achievement Awards

**Blue Ribbon** = 600 points and above  
**Red Ribbon** = 450 – 599 points  
**White Ribbon** = 300 – 449 points

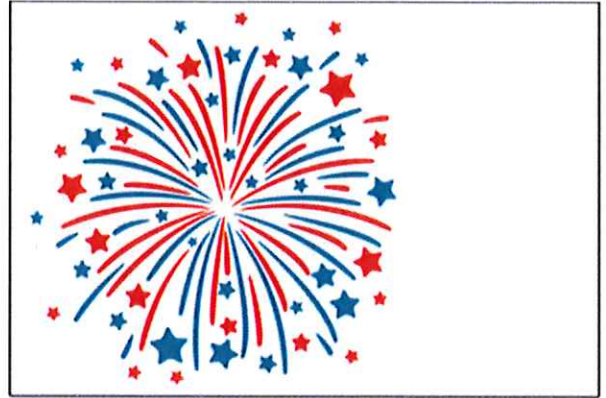
### Chapter Size Levels
