To receive recognition, chapters are required to complete the CMR electronically through eMembership BEFORE February 1, 2026. The CMR will be posted in August. Don't wait until the last minute to begin processing it.

Some suggestions as chapter regents for the Master Report would be to:

- 1) Make a hard copy of your chapter's Master Reports. Chapter regents can use this as a guideline for planning next year's activities of the committees that the chapter supports.
- 2) Share the finished report with your chapter members—glow in your accomplishments, plan for another year of achievements and success.
- 3) Name names! Cast the spotlight on your chapter members and showcase how vibrant and engaged your members and chapter are in fulfilling the missions of our Society.

The mission of the Chapter Achievement Awards (CAA) is to recognize chapters for their exceptional work as it applies to ALL committees, and All chapter sizes. To receive recognition, chapters are required to complete the CAA through the Chapter Master Report found on eMembership BEFORE February 1, 2026.
