Members Course

The Members Course is a great introduction to DAR! Course content consists of self-paced, online webinars that you will complete from the comfort of your home.

Members will watch 30 webinars; fill out a questionnaire on each; attend local and state events; and complete an independent project to learn more about what it means to be a Daughter of the American Revolution.

This course is a prerequisite to the New Horizons course.



Committee Leaders Course

The Committee Leaders Course focuses on the aspects of committee leadership and helps chairs learn how to become effective leaders, set goals, plan events, and work effectively with their team.

Whether you are a new or experienced chapter chair, state chair, national chair, or national vice chair, you are guaranteed to learn something new from this course by completing the 17 webinars and three committee workbooks that encourage you to delve into the available resources on the Members webpage. You will plan a fictional chapter service project or event that does not need to be implemented to complete this course.



New Horizons Course

Members who aspire to serve as an officer or committee chair at the chapter, state, or national level are encouraged to complete the New Horizons Course. Completion of the Members Course is a prerequisite, and a signed form from your chapter regent is required to enroll in this course.

After completing 20 self-directed modules; three officer workbooks; participating in local, state, and national events; and demonstrating your leadership by completing a capstone project, you will be better prepared to navigate the complexities of parliamentary procedure, conflict resolution, budgeting, and financial tools, among others.
