



What is the SIP?

- It is the State Information Packet, the state equivalent of the National Information Packet (NIP)
- The SIP contains information from:
 - ❖ state officers
 - ❖ state chairs of national committees
 - ❖ state chairs of state committees
 - ❖ presidents of WVDAR clubs
- It may include:
 - ❖ an explanation of information and deadlines in the NIP or found on the national website
 - ❖ state deadlines and information for contests, reports, upcoming events, or other submissions
 - ❖ information on state clubs and requirements for admission
 - ❖ contact information for questions and submissions
- The SIP typically is updated for the current year in the Fall, although more information may be added later.
- All submissions for the SIP should be sent to the State Vice Regent, who will convert to PDF if necessary and forward to the State VIS Chair to upload on the WVDAR members' only webpage.
